



THE GOVERNOR'S CHALLENGE 2013

1. Completion of the Governor's Challenge will qualify the club for the Presidential Citation.
2. Completion of ONE additional item in each category listed in the Presidential Citation will qualify the club for the Presidential Citation with Distinction.

Promote Membership Growth

1. Attract and retain members to achieve a minimum net gain of **at least one** member between 1 July and 1 March.
2. Submit 2013-2014 membership development goals using Rotary Club Central.
3. Encourage membership engagement by ensuring that **every member** has participated in **at least one** service activity and one club social activity.
4. Completion of RLI by the **First Class President** and at least **one other member** in RY 2013-2014

Enhance Humanitarian Service Through Our Foundation

1. Participate in a local or international service project related to at least **three (3)** of Rotary's areas of focus (Peace and Conflict prevention/resolution/Disease Prevention and Treatment/Water and Sanitation/Maternal and Child Health/Basic Education and Literacy/Economic and Community Development)
2. Submit 2013-2014 Rotary Foundation giving goals using Rotary Club Central.
3. Support polio eradication through a community fundraising initiative & implement a public awareness campaign to inform the community about Rotary's contributions to polio eradication.

Strengthen Our Network Through the Family of Rotary

1. Hold **at least one** fellowship or service activity that involves **all club members and their families** and/or Partner with a non-Rotary organization on a service project in your community.
2. Use Rotary Showcase to regularly publicize your club's activities, enhance public image and recruit prospective members.
3. Support New Generations programs in **at least one** of the following ways:
 1. Sponsor a new Rotaract or Interact club or support an existing one
 2. Pair Rotarian mentors with Rotaractors in your community.
 3. Conduct a joint project with an Interact or Rotaract club.
 4. Sponsor or participate in a Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA) event.
 5. Sponsor or host at least one Youth Exchange student.
